The Story of This Wine. Like the ghost that haunts our winemaker's house, Parapine has mysteriously returned. This Grenache, like many of our other wines, was demanding to be made and shared. Savory, balanced flavors with a bold, lasting finish. Enjoy it while it lasts, as we're not sure if or when it will reappear.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes. "Heady aromas of black cherry liqueur, wild strawberry, candied tarragon, tangerine zest, forest floor, mountain wildflowers, and herbes de Provence. This is a dark, deeply flavored Grenache, coating the palate with dark red raspberry, black cherry, damp desert herbs, wildflowers, and chalky mineral notes. As always, this wine is delicious for immediate gratification purposes, but will be great out of the cellar for the next 7-10 years." - Chris Peterson, Winemaker

"The 2023 'Parapine' is a stunning follow-up to the delicious '22 bottling. This edition has 11% Mourvèdre blended in, and this was stored for 14 months in neutral oak before bottling. This is brimming with bright red fruits on the nose alongside fresh sage and Mandarin orange zest. The palate is polished and lithe with a smooth mouthfeel and loads of heady red fruits. Smooth and seamless throughout the drinking experience, enjoy this beauty now and over the next eight to ten years. Drink 2025-2033."
